



CODE OF CONDUCT

I. PREAMBLE

Participation in the **GISUTECH INTERNATIONAL ROBOTICS AND TECHNOLOGY COMPETITION** is a truly Fun Experience but all Finalists, adult supervisors, and guests are expected to fulfill certain responsibilities and obligations, including complying with This Code of Conduct of GISUTECH INTERNATIONAL ROBOTICS AND TECHNOLOGY COMPETITION:

II. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- a) All students must attend the GISUTECH COMPETITION with an adult supervisor (a teacher or a parent).
- b) A Finalist is any participant who was officially chosen and sent an official invitation letter to compete in the specified Project Olympiad Round.
- c) GISUTECH COMPETITION will provide an environment where participants will be treated with respect and without any discrimination whatsoever.
- d) Participants (Students and Supervisors) of GISUTECH COMPETITION will conduct themselves in a manner consistent with this Code of Conduct and abiding to the rules and regulations defined by the GISUTECH COMPETITION(www.gisutech.com/#!rules/c10b6.).
GISUTECH COMPETITION reserves the right to disqualify any participant from any and all activities, who is deemed in violation of the code of conduct and rules and regulations.
- e) All Participants (finalists and supervisors) MUST refrain from any behavior that constitutes sexual harassment, defined as unwelcome sexual advances or unwelcome conduct of a sexual nature.
- f) All Participants (finalists and supervisors) MUST refrain from any behavior that constitutes harassment, where harassment is defined as comment or conduct, directed towards an individual or group, which is offensive, abusive, racist, sexist, degrading or malicious.

III. PARTICIPANTS

All participants involved in GISUTECH COMPETITION MUST:

- a) Maintain their discipline throughout the Competition program.
- b) Maintain integrity in all aspects of scientific research, (avoid any scientific misconduct or fraud).
- c) Communicate in English well enough to present their projects.
- d) Respect all other individuals.
- e) Direct criticism and comments appropriately and respectfully.
- f) Demonstrate ethical conduct and practices.
- g) Maintain decent attire in all programs and events of GISUTECH COMPETITION.
- h) Comply at all times with the Rules and Regulations of GISUTECH COMPETITION.
- i) Be courteous and cooperative with the GISUTECH COMPETITION judges and organizers.
- j) NOT use cellphones during the judging period.
- k) Abstain from the use of alcohol, tobacco and non-medicinal drugs.
- l) Be punctual to all GISUTECH COMPETITION events that they are required to attend.

IV. SUPERVISORS

All supervisors of GISUTECH COMPETITION MUST:

- a) Ensure the expectations for finalist behavior and conduct are made clear to their students.
- b) Provide supervision for their finalists in an appropriate manner.
- c) If need arises, provide assistance and supervision to other finalists.
- d) Ensure punctuality of finalists at organized events is fulfilled.
- e) Ensure finalists adhere to the set programme for the day.
- f) Communicate and cooperate with parents of finalists.
- g) Abstain from the use of alcohol, tobacco and non-medicinal drugs during the GISUTECH COMPETITION exhibition.
